### Restrictions

Individuals may not be elected or co-opted to serve on the Board if any of the following apply

- the person is an undischarged bankrupt or is subject to a condition not yet fulfilled or any order under the Insolvency Act 1967.
- the person has been convicted of a crime involving dishonesty (within the meaning of section 2 (1) of the Crimes Act 1961) and has been sentenced for that within last seven years.
- the person has been prohibited from being a director or promoter of, or being concerned or taking part in, the management of an incorporated or unincorporated body under the Companies Act 1993, Securities Act 1978, the Securities Market Act 1988, the Takeovers Act 1993 or from being an officer of a charitable entity under the Charities Act 2005; or
- the person is subject to a property order made that the person is lacking in competence to manage their own affairs under the Protection of Personal and Property Rights Act 1988, or whose property is managed by a trustee corporation under section 32 of the Protection and Property Rights Act 1988.
