MATTERS ARISING

Bowls Waikato AGM - Maia Wilson has volunteered to be the Tokoroa Club Delegate.

FINANCE

LM presented the Annual Accounts which have been reviewed by Ken Solly. While the Club has made a profit – it is well down on the previous year. This can be attributed to several reasons – we did not actively seek sponsorship – we did not hold any open tournaments apart from the Anniversary Classic and Business House income was well down due to weather.

GENERAL BUSINESS

R & M - Working Bee held previous Tuesday was well supported

Match Committee – Bit of a Do was deemed "brilliant" by all those who attended although the numbers were a bit disappointing. Several reasons were put forward – time of day – relevance (not getting a prize so why attend) etc. Suggestions for next year included still maintaining the "Bit of a Do" format but combining it with Closing Day.

Subscriptions for 2021/22 - LM proposed that the subscriptions be increased for the following reasons:

Our Current Subscription – Full Members \$85.00 (plus Main Club \$20)

is dispersed as follows : Bowls NZ Capitation Fees \$39.11 Bowls Waikato Capitation Fees \$33.13

Leaving the Tokoroa Bowling Club with only **\$12.76** to run the administration of the Club.

Given that income is dropping, and sponsorship is becoming increasingly harder to get – it was felt that we need to increase the Annual Subscription by \$10 to \$95.00 which will give us \$22.00 to work with. We would still be one of the cheaper clubs around.

After much discussion it was agreed that the Subscription should be increased by \$10 for the Full, Casual and 1st year memberships but retain the \$15 subscription for Student members

Moved that we increase our annual subscription to: Full \$95.00 - Casual -\$40.00 1st year \$50.00 - Student \$15.00 - L Murphy/K Kendall (Carried)

Gordon Bond — Gordon has qualified to represent Bowls Waikato in the National Champ Champs to be held in NaeNae in July. To show our support, it is proposed that we make a contribution towards his travel costs. It was also proposed that we approach the Main Club for of \$250 and we would match this.
